

Ordinance No. 6 - Parking on Public Streets

An Ordinance relative to parking on certain public streets in said Village.

The Village of Beulah Ordains:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, or corporation to park or leave standing any automotive vehicle, truck or automobile or any other vehicle or conveyance for more than one hour upon the street of said Village hereafter designated.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any persons above named to stop in said Street or double park any truck, automobile, or other automotive vehicle or other vehicle of any kind in the restricted zone of said Village herein after named.

Section 3. The street and restricted zone referred to in this Ordinance shall include that part of Benzie Boulevard lying and being between Crystal Avenue and Clark Street in said Village.

Section 4. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance on conviction thereof shall be punished by a find of not to exceed \$100.00, or imprisonment in the county jail for a term not exceeding 90 days, or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.
