

Chapter 5001—1, 2, 3 & 4 House Trailers Ordinance 66-1

1. No person shall place or locate any camper, RV, tent, or other type of movable or temporary housing anywhere in the Village of Beulah, except when unoccupied and then for a period not to exceed three days, also except in any duly licensed trailer park.
2. Unoccupied trailers, campers, etc. may be parked or stored within the Village limits by Special Permit to be issued at the discretion of the Common Council of the Village.
3. Special permit fee is one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per month.
4. No fish shanties or other type of movable structure shall be kept or stored within the Village limits, except when being moved, for a period not exceeding three days.

Penalty.

Any person who fails to correct a violation of any provision of this Ordinance within the specified date of the notice ordering the correction shall be guilty of a municipal civil infraction as defined in Public Act 12 of 1994, amending Public Act 236 of 1961, being Sections 600.101-600.9939 of Michigan Compiled Laws, and shall be subject to a fine of not more than Five Hundred and 00/100 (\$500.00) Dollars. Each day this Ordinance is violated shall be considered as a separate violation.

In addition to enforcing this Ordinance through the use of a municipal civil infraction proceeding, the Village may initiate proceedings in the Circuit Court to abate or eliminate the nuisance per se or any other violation of this Ordinance.
