Crystal Lake & Watershed Association (CLWA) Update:

Swimmer's itch 2022. In early summer the CLWA announced the suspension of its merganser relocation program for the control of swimmer's itch (SI). The Michigan Department of Natural Resources had ordered the halt due to the presence of avian influenza in the state. Despite this, the incidence of SI remained low throughout summer 2022. Anecdotal evidence was supported by two studies of the snail infection rate and incident reports on the CLWA website and at the Congregational Assembly beach, which showed little change from 2021. Unfortunately, as of this writing the DNR's suspension remains in place, so that resumption of the relocation program in 2023 appears unlikely. The CLWA encourages the public to check its website, crystallakewatershed.org, for updates and information on ways to avoid contracting SI.

Snow Fall in Benzie County:

Accumulated snowfall as of 2/17/2023 is 65.75". Total snowfall for 2021-22 was 86". The lowest total recorded snowfall was 33.5" in 1973/74 and the most, 230", during 2013-14. You can find more snowfall information and other topics at www.benziecrd.org




Short Term Rental News



Recent changes made to Beulah's Short-Term Rental (STR) Ordinance. All STR owners are required to register their unit(s) and pay an annual registration fee for each unit before their first rental. **The fee has been increased from \$100 to \$200 per unit.** Registration Forms are available on the village website, VillageofBeulah.net or at the Village Office. A Village Visitor Guide is also available for posting in rental units. Additionally, Section 7 paragraph 2.C. has been amended to read "Provisions for trash disposal consistent with Village Ordinances must be provided." The STR Ordinance in its entirety is also available on the village
