The Village of Beulah Welcomes You to Beulah Beach RV Park 2023 Season:

Through your multiple requests and suggestion from last year, we have implemented improvements and changes, read the 2023 rules completely and carefully. No one will be allowed park entry until we have signed acknowledgement of 2023 rules and you have received application approval. Please note, 2023 lot fees reflect the second 10% increase as approved in 2021 and remaining balance is due upon arrival this year.

First, the ground has been leveled as much as possible on the lake side of the camp ground. Over one hundred yards of top soil has been added and new seed applied. With that said, the surface will still be a bit softer than last year. Additionally, the grass is still “seedling-new”, therefore we will be strictly enforcing the No Ground Covering Rule that we rescinded last year. Two pallets per RV as written in the rules is all that will be allowed, your attention to this matter is appreciated.

To address the multiple accessibility requests that were made due to the erosion protection installed in 2022, we have installed a Handicap Access at the East end of the park, between the Public Beach Restrooms and lot number one. The Mobi Mat will allow unimpeded access for all mobility impairments, from cane to wheelchair. Additionally, it will allow for boat entrance and egress as well as loading. Also, accessibility for Emergency Response Vehicles is of utmost importance, with this in mind, parking will be enforced this year as noted in rules.

The Sea Wall has been repaired and reinforced again this year. To ensure the minimization of additional damage due to costal surge changes, we are going to enforce the long-standing rule of No Boats on the Beach—All vessels to include Pontoon legs or Sea legs shall be moored in a secure manner and in line with the orange buoys or beyond. The area between the orange buoys and the beach of the RV Park is considered the swim area for the RV Park residents.

Please take note that charging on electric vehicles is strictly prohibited.

Thank you to all who replied to our cable survey. The Council has decided to continue complementary cable for 2023. Beginning 2024 Cable-Internet Services will be available at personal expense, with a carrier of your choice.
