

Village of Beulah
2022 Boat Dock Rules and Regulations

1. Completed permit and fees MUST be received by the Village Office by 4/2/2022. Applications and fees not received by this date and time will result in immediate forfeiture of the assigned dock space.
2. Applicant must be a current resident or own property within the Village of Beulah at the time of application. If property is sold the dockage space is forfeited and the Village office must be notified immediately.
3. A copy of the current watercraft registration for the 2022 season must be returned with the completed application. The watercraft registration name must correspond to the resident or property owner. An expired 2021 registration may be submitted with the application; however, the renewed registration must be on file by May 20, 2022 by 2:00 P.M. or your docking permit will be revoked immediately & indefinitely.
4. The Village of Beulah will determine the alignment of the docks and will be marked accordingly. The dock must be centered directly with this line. Docks must be in single wide sections only. No platform sections at end of dock will be allowed. All numbers will be valid After April 16, 2022 for the 2022 permit year and will be painted on the west side of Lake St. Docks and hoists not in-line will be re-positioned at a charge of \$75.00 per ten-foot section.
5. All docks shall be shared by two permit holders. The maintenance of a shared dock is the responsibility of the dock owner; however the village encourages permit holders to share the responsibility.
6. Absolutely NO sub-letting, renting, commercial use or usage of dock and/or hoist Rights by those other than the permit holder.
7. All docks and hoists need to be placed and occupied with the licensed watercraft submitted on the application by July 1st of each year. If a space is not occupied by July 1st of each year, the council reserves the right to cancel that permit. The applicant of that permit will then be moved to the bottom of the wait list and the next person on the top of the list will be offered the option to become the permit holder. Docks and hoists must be removed from the Village property and bottomlands by November 1, 2022. Failure to comply will result in the Village of Beulah removing the Docks and/or hoist(s) and assessing charges not less than \$250.00 and loss of future Dock permits for the owner (s) of the dock and/or hoist (s) at the discretion of the Village Council.
8. Transfer of dock permit MAY be granted by Village Council vote, to surviving family property owner in the event of death, or by property transfer to an immediate (spouse, sibling) family member if family member conforms to all regulations. Please contact the village office as you must appear at a Village Council meeting for this request.

9. Any switching of dock assignments must be submitted in writing to the Village signed by all parties involved and will be approved either by the Chairperson or Co-Chairperson of Parks and Recreation.
10. The granting of a boat dock permit does not create a property interest in such permit or any entitlement that such permit will continue unabated. The Village of Beulah may Refuse to grant a permit if it determines that the applicant:
- A) has violated any provision of the Village Ordinance or state law if such person's conduct constituted a hazard to public health, safety, or welfare.
 - B) has had a boat dock permit within the Village revoked within three years of the date of the present application.
 - C) has violated any provision of the Boat Dock Rules and Regulations within three years of the date of the present application; or
 - D) has failed to pay a fine or fee lawfully imposed on him/her pursuant to this Boat Dock Rules and Regulations or Village Ordinance or is delinquent in any payment to the Village of Beulah.
11. The Village of Beulah may revoke a permit if it determines that the permittee:
- A) has violated any provision of the Village Ordinance or state law if such a person's conduct constituted a hazard to public health, safety, or welfare;
 - B) has violated any provision of this Boat Dock Rule and Regulations; or
 - C) has failed to pay a fine or fee lawfully imposed on him/her pursuant to this Boat Dock Rules and Regulations or Village Ordinance or is delinquent in any payment to the Village of Beulah.
12. You will be notified by certified mail to your mailing address on your application if your docking permit is revoked and you will have three days to remove your dock/hoist from the bottomlands of Crystal Lake. Failure to comply will result in any expenses incurred to be billed and possibly shared by the permit holders of that assigned space.

Individuals responsible for having use of Village property for boat docking shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Village of Beulah, its insurers, its agents and representatives, from any and all suits, actions, claims, or demands of any character or nature arising out of or brought on account of any injuries for damages sustained by any person as a consequence or result of using Village Property for boat docking.

By vote of the Beulah Village Council, these rules may be amended at any time. Rules approved by vote at the February 4, 2022 Village Council Meeting.
