

AMENDMENT TO SUBSTANTIAL PUBLIC HEALTH RISK PROJECT GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT, GREAT LAKES, AND ENERGY AND THE VILLAGE OF BEULAH (Authorized by 2022 PA 53)

This Amendment modifies the grant agreement between the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (hereafter "State"), formerly Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, and the **Village of Beulah** (hereafter "Grantee"), signed by the State on **October 25, 2023,** for the **Wastewater Treatment Improvements Project.** This Amendment does not take effect until signed by both parties.

The revisions to the Grant Agreement are limited to those specified below. All other provisions of the Agreement remain in effect.

PROJECT SCOPE (WORK PLAN)

The State and the Grantee agree to the following clarification in project scope:

"The Village of Beulah owns and operates a facultative lagoon and spray irrigation wastewater treatment system. This system is failing, causing sanitary sewer overflows, water quality violations, and impacting groundwater and the Betsie River. This project includes critical upgrades to the wastewater treatment plant, including a new headworks building, a new moving bed bioreactor system, tertiary filtering, a new center pivot spray irrigation system, and proper lagoon abandonment."

Added clarification: The Village is currently under an Administrative Consent Order and is working to take initial steps to bring their current system into compliance until they secure additional funding through alternate sources to complete the necessary upgrades to their wastewater treatment plant. Costs related to these measures, including preliminary engineering work and planning/design of the upgrades are eligible under this grant.
